### The successful candidate will ideally:

- ✚ Possess 1-3 years of experience working at a nonprofit, providing program support to small nonprofit.
- ✚ Experience providing mental health/trauma services to children and adolescents.
- ✚ Demonstrated ability to develop trusting relationships with youth.
- ✚ Experience working in de-escalating crises is highly desirable
- ✚ Must be licensed in Washington, DC as LPC/LSW; LPCC/LISW preferred.
- ✚ Must have knowledge of child and family development; individual/group/family counseling techniques; solution-focused, short-term treatment techniques; and mental health/chemical dependency diagnoses (DSM-IV/DSM-V).
- ✚ Be well-organized, highly motivated, and able to work effectively on multiple tasks and priorities at once.
- ✚ Experience working in underserve communities, schools, and/or community-based (nonprofit) agencies.
- ✚ Attention to cultural competence in all manner of family and community engagement.
- ✚ Access to a car, possession of a valid driver's license, and proof of automobile insurance
- ✚ Ability to successfully pass a background check.

### Responsibilities:

Working under the direction of the President, this position is primarily responsible for:

- ✚ Provides outpatient individual, group and family therapy to children, adolescents, and families in a variety of settings.
- ✚ Performs diagnostic assessments as necessary.
- ✚ Develops client-centered ISPs, monitors and reviews progress.
- ✚ Arranges appointments and collateral contacts and coordinates therapeutic efforts. Links, coordinates families to resources.
- ✚ Advocates on behalf of the client.
