NOTE:

- Sixty (60) credit hours are required for graduation with a 3.00 minimum cumulative grade point average.
- Field Education I and II* require 2 days per week in the field.
- Field Education III & IV* require 2 1/2 days per week in the field.
- Field of Practice I* must be completed concurrently with *Field Education III*
- Field of Practice II* must be completed concurrently with *Field Education IV*
- Field of Practice* courses may be taken as electives ONLY during the student's advanced year, following completion of all first year courses, 30 credit hours.
