

PLANNED PART-TIME ENROLLMENT

The planned part-time curriculum allows students to complete course work in three or four years. The first year/first two semesters are used to complete foundation courses: Human Behavior & the Social Environment I & II; Social Welfare Policy & Services I & II, Research Methods for Social Workers, and Data Analysis for Social Workers. Enrollment in Field Education begins in the second year/third semester of enrollment.

Concurrent enrollment in field of practice courses (*Family and Child Welfare Services, Criminal Justice, Health, Mental Health, Social Gerontology, or Displaced Populations I and II*) while enrolled in *Field Education III & IV*, and practice methods III & IV (*Intervention Planning & Strategies and Intervention with Selected Clinical Problems* for direct practice majors, and *Human Service Administration and Resource Development* for CAP Practice majors) is required. This is necessary to foster the development, integration, application and reinforcement of practice knowledge and skills.
